## 1, Machines

All eligible machines must conform to AMCA specifications and safety standards.

#### 2. Safety.

Safety clothing, safety helmets etc., must be worn and conform to AMCA specifications.

#### 3. Course.

Moderate to easy off road course approximately 5 miles from Haverfordwest. Mixture of open lanes and single track with no significant obstacles. For riders of all abilities. This is a 'hare and hounds' rather than a time card enduro, with the winning rider completing the most laps during the allotted time period

## 4. Start

Separate Youth Race consisting 1 event of 75 minutes + 1 lap, run prior to the main adult event of 2 sessions of 75 minutes + 1 lap

#### 5. Entries

Maximum of 100 adult entries (first come, first served

#### 6. Fee

Fee of £50 solo - A charge of £10 extra for non-AMCA licence holders.

Online entries only via available on Classic MX Wales website.

## 7. Insurance

Insurance is included in the entry fee.

10. Classes . (The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate classes.)

Youth: riders up to 16 years old, no bikes over 125cc

- 1. Small Wheel 65cc
- 2. 2. Big Wheel 65-85cc
- 3. Up to 125cc

## Adult

- 1. Modern: Enduro (road registered), any capacity
- 2. Modern: Motocross, any capacity
- 3. Pit Bike
- 4. Trail Bike up to 500cc (must be road registered)
- 5. Trail / Adventure Bike over 500cc (must be road registered)
- 6. Classic Motocross or Enduro (pre 1974)
- 7. Twinshock MX or Enduro (drum brakes, aircooled, twin shock)

## 11. Camping

This is available on the Saturday night only

## 12. Refuelling

A refuelling area will be available and this should be the only area used during racing. A Fire Extinguisher should be provided by competitors alongside a suitable container for refuelling.

## 13. Scoring

Each class winner will be determined as that rider who completes the most laps. For those riders completing the same number of laps, it will be those doing it in the shortest time. For the adult class, it will be the total laps from both sessions with the first to complete the laps in the second session.

## 14. Route

The route will be clearly marked and taped where appropriate. A riders briefing will be held prior to the event. Any riders not staying on the route or taking shortcuts will be disqualified.

#### **DECLARATION**
